## BOOTH AGREEMENT

In consideration for being granted a Booth at the 2009 Israel Independence Festival (the "Festival") at Congregation B'nai B'rith (CBB), 1000 San Antonio Creek Road, Santa Barbara, California on Sunday May 3, 2009 from 11:00 am to 4:00 pm, the undersigned agrees to all of the following terms and conditions:

1. Only the number of booths reserved and paid for will be supplied on May 3, 2009.
2. Tables, tablecloths, umbrellas, canopies and any other display equipment is the responsibility of the booth renter.
3. CBB will provide chairs (up to four). Your request must be made on the Booth Application.
4. Set-up for your Booth will take place between 8:00 a.m. and 10:30 a.m. The event opens to the public at 11:00 a.m. and will conclude at 4:00 p.m.
5. All materials from Booth must be removed by 5:00 p.m. the day of the event. The tear down of Booth may not begin before 4:00 p.m.
6. The organizers of the Festival have sole discretion as to the placement of the Booth.
7. The organizers of the Festival reserve the right to cancel this contract at any time by returning payment.
8. None of the organizers of the Festival, the volunteers helping with the Festival or CBB are or shall be responsible for the theft, loss, or breakage of personal or Booth materials.
9. The organizers of the Festival make no representations or warranties other than those expressly set forth in this contract.
10. Any special requests for additional Booth needs must be made in writing and on the Booth Application.
11. In light of Santa Barbara's variable weather (fog, wind, sun – yes, even rain) we recommend that you seriously consider bringing a canopy.
12. Electrical access needs must be requested on the Booth Application. Only a limited number of Booths may have access to electricity, for which there will be a \$50 additional charge. Electricity will be provided only to those who have requested and paid for it. You must provide your own UL-approved extension cord.
13. No generators or other sources of loud noise or music.
14. No ID will be required for Booth participants. The event is free for the public, so you may have as many people assisting at your booth as you like.
15. You may park in CBB's lot while you unload your materials, but then must move your vehicle to street parking. We will provide someone to watch your unloaded materials while you find a parking space. You MUST do this before you locate and begin setting up your Booth/Display. We strongly urge you to bring a dolly or hand truck for transferring your materials to your booth.

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- 16. A volunteer will direct you to your Booth, which will have your name on it. You may arrange your booth any way you wish, as long as all merchandise and displays remain within the designated parameters defined by your selection of the Booth Application.
- 17. There is no rain contingency date. Our celebration will take place regardless of the weather.
